NOTES:

1. This is a guide to cleaning maintenance. The frequency of carrying out the methods nominated depends on the assessment of the traffic rating, carpet construction, and health considerations.
2. The traffic volumes of light/medium/heavy/very heavy should not be confused with terms and definitions used in end-use classification schemes, which are based on carpet performance due to traffic. The traffic volume for cleaning purposes refers to the number of persons using an area and contributing to light soiling, medium soiling, heavy soiling and very heavy soiling.
